


Site Plan Review Process

Site Plan Review (SPR) is a process used to examine all proposed developments, except single family detached residential, for the purpose of ensuring compliance local and state requirements. The purpose of a site plan review is to ensure that all applicable requirements of the zoning ordinance are complied with prior to the issuance of a zoning and building permit. The SPR Committee consists of representatives from various state and agencies who will address the of the project including zoning, codes, health building standards, traffic/highway regulations, drainage/road requirements, compliance with wetland regulations, Storm and Water regulations.
